Procedure :

- Start the automated ice bin cleaning process.**
On the left hand screen, press the menu button, next press the Clean & Sanitize Task Selection Button.



- Select the Bi-weekly / Monthly cleaning & Sanitizing Button and the Clean and Sanitize Button.
Press the green arrow to start the cleaning process.



- Switch OFF the Ice Maker.**
Switch off the Icemaker and perform periodic cleaning or de-scaling procedures. Refer to the Icemaker manufacturer's instructions manual or PM cards.



Note : For reducing the amount of ice cubes left inside the hopper, it is advised to switch off the icemaker a couple of hours before starting with the ice bin cleaning.



- Remove the Conveyor and put aside in a safe and clean place.**
Refer to the PM card with **DAILY CLEANING** instructions.



Cleaning and Sanitizing the Ice Bin (Continued)

5 Install the Ice collection Tray

Place the ice collection tray onto the conveyor grille and under the ice gate.



6 Evacuate all ice from the Ice Hopper.

Press and hold the ICE DUMP button to evacuate ice from the Hopper.

When the ice tray is full, stop the ice dump process, discard ice and repeat until the ice hopper is empty.



7 Prepare the 3 buckets with cleaning/rinsing solutions.

- Bucket #1 filled with HA detergent.
- Bucket #2 filled with clean warm water.
- Bucket #3 filled with DR sanitizer.



8 Locate the cleaning accessory access door on the lower right hand side of the unit, and pull the 2 cleaning hose out.

WARNING: To avoid contamination, keep the cleaning hoses away from the floor.



9 Prepare to Clean the Hopper

Put the strainer hose into Bucket #1 filled with McDonald's HA detergent / cleaning solution.



10 Prepare to Clean the Hopper

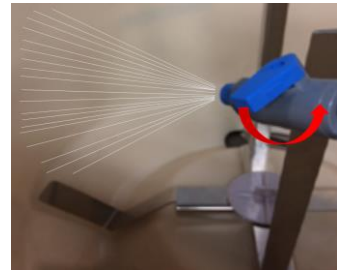
Prior to continue make sure that the valve is CLOSED.

21 Prepare to Rinse the Hopper

Put the strainer hose into Bucket #2 filled with Clean warm water



22 Prepare to Rinse the Hopper

Prior to continue make sure that the valve is CLOSED.

Open the manual refill door and put the spray hose inside the hopper.



23 Start the rinsing process.

When ready, press the START CLEANING PUMP button, open the spray valve with a 90° turn and begin spraying around the hopper and all corners. Spray until the bucket is empty.



WARNING: Avoid spraying upwards into the icemaker and onto the icemaker adapter.

24 Hopper Rinsing

When the bucket is empty, immediately press the STOP CLEANING PUMP button and close the valve.



25 Post-cleaning phase

Drain both cleaning hoses and return into the unit.



26 Post-cleaning phase

Make sure the ice refill door is closed and locked.



27 Switch ON the Ice Maker.

Switch the Ice Maker back ON.



28 Re-install the Conveyor and lid.

Make sure all parts are properly installed. Next, return the ABS to AUTOMATIC mode.



29 Wrap-up.

Gather all cleaning equipment, buckets and ice collection tray, sanitize, rinse with water and dry.



Store all cleaning accessories in a dry, clean and safe place.
